## Job Purpose

To coordinate activity to identify and manage the risk to young people at risk of youth violence and/or exploitation and to support the development the knowledge and skills of the workforce through advice, guidance and training.

## Key Responsibilities

- 1. Coordinate and provide professional support to the Youth Violence and Criminal Exploitation (YVCE) panel.
- 2. Devise and maintain a system for tracking cases coming to panel to provide assurance re completion of agreed actions and impact upon outcomes
- Collate Risk Assessments completed by Social Workers and Youth Justice Case Managers, with responsibility for checking information provided and having a role in ascertaining which cases meet the threshold to be heard at the YVCE panel and communicating outcomes
- 4. Provide advice and guidance to professionals in Children's Services about pathways and risk management of young people at risk of criminal exploitation or youth violence
- 5. Act as a champion for Child Exploitation across Children's Services
- 6. Support with writing and disseminating procedures/guidance
- 7. Support the development and delivery of training
- 8. Support the development and maintenance of a Nottinghamshire risk profile for child exploitation
- 9. Support the development of Nottinghamshire Approach to Contextual Safeguarding which will align pathways for different types of exploitation and radicalisation.

## **Key Accountabilities**

- 1. Closely working with internal and external partners
- 2. To deliver services within the Service's scheme of delegation for safeguarding children and local safeguarding children board policies.
- 3. To ensure that personal practice is in line with service guidance
- 4. To operate within the framework of any professional registration.
- 5. To actively contribute to the professional development of yourself and others
- To participate fully in supervision, appraisals (EPDR), and practice observations, as part of personal development and support
- 7. To maintain a current knowledge and awareness of legislation, policy, procedure and practice in the post holder's field of work

## The post holder will perform any duty or task that is appropriate for the role described

- 7. A minimum of 2 years experience working with young people with multiple complex needs
- 8. Experience in managing risk in respect of young people

## Personal skills and general competencies

- 3. A high level of personal drive and commitment to excellent customer care and the ability to set an example for other staff
- 4. Strong interpersonal skills to gain the agreement and acceptance of others including colleagues, senior managers and children, young people and their parents.
- 5. Ability to make decisions and solve problems to meet operational targets, involving devising solutions and prioritising the resources available
- 6. Information technology skills including use of databases and word processing.
