Job Purpose The Caterer/Caretaker at Hagg Farm will be responsible for assisting with cleaning, catering at Hagg Farm, caretaking including security of the premises and its contents, and other duties arising from the use of premises. The post-holder may also be required to contribute to caretaking, cleaning and catering at St. Michael's, Hathersage. At both centres, the post holder may be required to undertake the following duties:		
Key Responsibilities Cleaning/catering and general domestic duties <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The cleaning of the premises and maintaining high standards of hygiene throughout the centre, including maintaining floor surfaces in accordance with the requirements of the Authority.2. Laundry and bed-making duties as required.3. The security of the premises, together with its contents if last to leave the building.4. Assisting with the arrival and departure of schools and other users of the premises including some weekends.5. Assist with the catering arrangements including the planning of menus, purchase of food and preparation and cooking of meals, in liaison with the Catering Supervisor.6. Maintenance of high standard of hygiene and health and safety in the kitchen, dining and food storage areas;7. In the absence of the Catering/Caretaking Supervisor ensure that adequate domestic supplies are maintained to meet the needs of the establishment		Key Accountabilities <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Accountable for personal health and safety, NCC Health and Safety procedures to be followed at all times e.g. COSHH/Risk assessment and following manufacturers recommended instructions at all times.2. Accountable for efficient personal time keeping, working to set/agreed work standards and high standards of customer care.

8. Taking reasonable care for the health and safety of him/her-self and all other persons affected by his/her activities 9. Providing first aid to staff and visitors if required. 10. Other reasonable caretaking duties if required on occasions.	
The post holder will perform any duty or task that is appropriate for the role described.
