Job Purpose

To provide maintenance services to the Worksop Production Unit and Rainworth Distribution Unit and to act as relief driver as required by the service.

Key Responsibilities

- 1. Developing & maintaining a planned maintenance programme and keeping appropriate records.
- 2. Maintaining and deep cleaning all equipment as necessary, including ovens, bratt pans, dish washers and mixing machines. This involves a close liaison with the Production Supervisor.
- 3. Assessing breakdowns and the need for specialist contractors. Carrying out repairs to minimise operational down time and disruption to production.
- 4. Maintain all aspects of the building on a day to day basis.
- 5. Maintaining a stock of spare parts that may be required.
- 6. Testing and maintaining all inspection and testing equipment in accordance with quality procedures and maintaining records.
- 7. Close liaison with external contractors when on site and site supervisor.
- 8. Acting as a relief driver as necessary to ensure delivery schedules are met.
- 9. To carry out all duties and responsibilities with a can do attitude.

Key Accountabilities

- 1. To ensure planned maintenance is undertaken on a regular basis.
- 2. Accountable for the accuracy of work undertaken and information provided.
- 3. To ensure that correct processes are being followed and to alert the appropriate manager to ensure compliance.
