

# Part Time Youth Support Worker Vacancy Frequently Asked Questions

# Is this a full time post?

No, this is a part time post which involves working on a youth session with young people from a Young People's Centre

# How long is a session?

Each session is 2.5 hours

## Are the sessions in the evening?

Yes

# What times are the youth sessions?

This varies depending on the youth club you would be working from, however times are usually between 6pm-9pm in the evening.

## Where are the posts based?

There are various posts available across Nottinghamshire, the Youth Service has 38 youth centres in all 7 districts; Mansfield, Ashfield, Newark and Sherwood, Broxtowe, Gedling and Rushcliffe – various posts will be available in these areas, successful candidates would be allocated a post pragmatically.

#### I'm looking for more than one post, how many posts are available?

There may be more than one post available to successful candidates, this will depend on outcome at interview.

#### Do you need any specific qualifications?

There is no specific qualifications required, but experience and understanding of working with young people aged 10-25 is desirable. If you are successful relevant training is required to fulfil this role.

# What training is involved?

Successful candidates would be required to attend a Level 1 Induction, and Level 2 in Youth Support Practice. This is a nationally recognised qualification. A great opportunity to build on knowledge and skills to fulfil the role successfully.
