- 3. Expert in Consultancy or Technical Specialism. Specialist knowledge and skills in one or more functions, technologies or industries.
- 4. Expert in the frameworks and principles on which networks, systems, equipment and resources are based. Examples: Windows NT, UNIX, Oracle, TDM, ATM, TCP/IP.
- 5. Proficient in standards associated with IT practice. Examples: PRINCE, SSADM, IEEE802.3, ITU (T), ETSI, IEC, BSI, ISO 9000.
- 6. Proficient in relevant national and international legislation. Examples: Data Protection Act, EU Procurement Directive. **Experience**
- 1. Must have 3 years previous experience in developing and maintaining the currently preferred electronic social care recording system.
